



## The Landmark Tavern

In 1868 Patrick Henry Carley opened the Landmark Tavern, an Irish Waterfront Saloon. In those days there was no 12th Avenue, just the shores of the Hudson River, on which his tavern sat. Mr, and Mrs, Carley designed their new saloon to be a practical home for their family and raised their children on the second and third floors. It remained as such until prohibition forced them to turn the third floor into a Speakeasy. As one of the oldest and continuing establishments in the City today, the Landmark Tavern still retains its Classic Old New York City Charm.
