islative assembly should comprise the whole people. But the ultimate lodgment of the sovereignty being the distinguishing feature, the introduction of the representative system does not remove a government from this type. However, a government of the latter kind is sometimes specifically described as a "representative democracy."

The words Republican, Democrat and Conservative are three of the most often and easiest words that can be used to divide the public. A REPUBLICAN is a "Member of U.S. political party started in the 1850s by a group of Democrats who split from the main party while a DEMOCRAT is someone that "Supports democracy but is liberal in their governmental ideals. They are usually republican or independent. Or they have their own ideas and don't fit anyone. CONSERVATISM is "An idea that supports free enterprise capitalism, traditional ideals, minimal government help, strict law, and gradual change. It started in 1750 and ended in 1850. It is nondoctrinated approach and practical outlook but does not approve of much progress. And then we have the Liberals and the Libertarians.

A LIBERAL is "If Nonpolitical, this is an entity that favors social solutions to economic, social, and other problems, and favors less law and restriction to personal freedoms and if Political, this is an entity that wants government to solve all of the economic and social problems without impacting that entity. A LIBERTARIAN is one who "Advocates for freedom related to social thought and conduct."

After reading all of the definitions above, it seems all of the persons involved in any of the parties or movements all want similar results I can only refer to them as Americans who
